



ARPA Projects

- ▶ Silver Springs Shores Septic-to-Sewer 4 Phases, Approximately 500 Parcels Each
 - Constructing Water Main and Gravity Sewer
- Update
 - ▶ Phase 1: Bids Opened on April 12, 2024
 - Phase 2: Bids Opened on March 14, 2024
 - ▶ Phase 3: 90% designed
 - ▶ Phase 4: Approaching 90% design







ARPA Projects

- Marion Oaks Water Main Extensions Completing All Water Mains North and East of CR484
 - ▶ Update: Construction Task Order Approved on March 19, 2024 Board Meeting, construction expected to be completed in late 2025





ARPA Projects

- ► The Centers Package Plant Decommissioning Installing Water Main and Force Main to The Centers to remove their existing WWTP and WTP
 - Construction Task Order Approved on January 10, 2024 Board Meeting
 - ▶ Update: Currently under construction, expected completion in late Summer 2024
