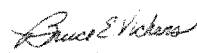

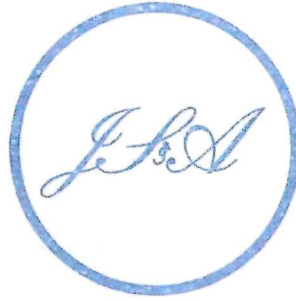

REPORT OF EVALUATION OF EDUCATIONAL CREDENTIALS

The following is a response to Mr. Gutierrez's request for a course-by-course evaluation of his academic credentials from Venezuela. This evaluation was prepared based on official original academic credentials.

Mr. Gutierrez attended the "Alonso Gamero" University Institute of Technology (*Instituto Universitario de Tecnología "Alonso Gamero"*) from 2003 to 2011. Founded in 1971, currently known as the "Alonso Gamero" Territorial Polytechnic University of Falcon (*Universidad Politécnica Territorial de Falcón "Alonso Gamero"*) the "Alonso Gamero" University Institute of Technology is a public institution of higher education accredited by the Ministry of the People's Power for Higher Education of Venezuela. In order to be admitted into the "Alonso Gamero" University Institute of Technology, applicants must have the high school diploma (*Bachiller*). This is the equivalent of graduation from a college preparatory program at an accredited high school in the United States.

Mr. Gutierrez completed the three-year undergraduate program and was awarded the degree of Higher University Technician in Industrial Instrumentation (*Técnico Superior Universitario en Instrumentación Industrial*) by the "Alonso Gamero" University Institute of Technology on August 26, 2013. This is the equivalent of the U.S. degree of Associate in Science in Industrial Instrumentation earned at a regionally accredited institution of higher education in the United States.
