A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE CITIZEN'S PARTICIPATION PLAN (CPP) AS REQUIRED BY HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT, 24 CFR PART 91.105, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND CERTIFICATIONS NEEDED; AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL BY HUD; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act 1974, as amended, the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has made grants available to Marion County, Florida to implement Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs; and

WHEREAS, under Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, as amended, HUD has made grants available to the Marion County Consortium, Florida to implement the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program; and

WHEREAS, under the Homeless Emergency Assistance and Rapid Transition to Housing Act of 2009 (HEARTH Act), as amended, HUD has made grants available to Marion County, Florida to implement the Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program; and

WHEREAS, under 24 CFR Part 91.105 as part of the Five (5) Year Consolidated Action Plan, each Entitlement Community shall submit a Citizen Participation Plan setting forth the policy and procedure for involving the citizens of Marion County in the planning and implementation of projects using Federal funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, that:

- 1: RECITALS. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2: ADOPTION. The Marion County Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the Citizen's Participation Plan attached hereto as "Exhibit A."
- 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
