WHEREAS, Marion County Fire Rescue is dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires, injuries, and fire fatalities through prevention and protection education; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Fire Prevention Week™ theme, "Charge into Fire Safety: Lithium-Ion Batteries in Your Home™", effectively serves to remind us of the importance of having working smoke alarms at home:
