Solid Waste

FY 24/25 – 3rd Quarter Accomplishments (April-June):

Improve Solid Waste Infrastructure and Update Solid Waste Master Plan

1. Performed preventative maintenance on 25% of our compactors at the recycling centers.
2. Developed draft scope to obtain a rail crossing from the sand mine property to the Baseline Landfill.
3. Created initial scope for the Baseline phase 1 and phase 2 landfill expansion.
4. Received 90% design for transfer station repairs.
5. Performed title search on Greenway property in efforts of ownership clean-up.
6. Awarded scope for mass grading design for the sand mine.
7. Awarded design and planning contract for new scale house building, received first round floor plan for review.
8. Presented budget to Administration
9. Intern started for summer work.
10. Bid new camera system for landfill property.
11. Drafted scope for ground water sampling and put out to bid.
12. Held two meetings with G2 on their operational plan and finalized a path forward.

FY 24/25 – 4th Quarter Goals (July - September):

Improve Solid Waste Infrastructure and Update Solid Waste Master Plan

1. Present the 25/26 budget to the Board.
2. Draft changes to a resolution regarding secondary fees charged by the department, to include non-assessed permits, code enforcement fees, intergovernmental fees, etc.
3. Award contract with engineering firm for design and permitting of phase 1 and phase 2 landfill expansion.
4. Conclude clean up ownership rights for a parcel in the yard waste area, currently showing Greenway ownership.
5. Finalize escrow payment for sand mine property, after all environmental permitting has been resolved by prior owner.
6. Finalize path forward for transfer station repairs, inclusive of floor, push walls, and elevated trailers.
7. Finalize procurement of new scale software and hardware.
8. Replace leachate sump pump to ensure efficient operations.
9. Award continuing services contract for engineering services.
10. Finalize G2 transition plan.
11. Award contracts for groundwater sampling and analysis for landfills.
12. Acquire and train on a new landfill gas analyzer.
13. Purchase some adjacent land to Newton Landfill to resolve fence and groundwater well placement.
14. Develop scope and plan to relocate the household hazardous waste and recycling center at Baseline.



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15. Finalize the mass grading plan for the sand mine property.
16. Finalize the electrical system updates for three recycling centers.
17. Award task for rail crossing design.
