

**RESOLUTION 21 R-\_\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF ONE (1) PARAMEDIC ON-CALL JOB CLASSIFICATION, PAY GRADE 99; AND ONE (1) EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN ON-CALL JOB CLASSIFICATION, PAY GRADE 99; WITHIN THE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT BUDGET AA305526; ALONG WITH THE CORRESPONDING JOB DESCRIPTION AND PAY GRADE AND INCORPORATING THE FOREGOING ACTIONS INTO THE MARION COUNTY CLASSIFICATION PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, it is required that all changes to the Classification and Pay Plan must be accomplished through Board approval and resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the job description and pay grade for the positions of Paramedic On-call and Emergency Medical Technician On-call are not current job classifications within the Marion County Classification Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, to create the classification of one (1) Paramedic On-call and one (1) Emergency Medical Technician On-call, in order to effectuate the proper and efficient administration of Marion County Human Resources as specifically provided for in this Resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, as follows:

**Section 1.** The creation of one (1) Paramedic On-call job description, Pay Grade 99; and one (1) Emergency Medical Technician On-call job description, Pay Grade 99; within the Fire Rescue department budget AA305526; along with the corresponding job description and pay grade, within the Fire Rescue department, is hereby approved.

**Section 2.** And incorporating the foregoing actions into the Marion County classification plan.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This resolution shall take effect August 17, 2021.
