A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE RECLASSIFICATION CHANGES TO THE FOLLOWING POSITIONS OF TWELVE (12) RIGHT OF WAY MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN AND THIRTEEN (13) LIGHT EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I, PAY GRADES 202 TO TWENTY-FIVE (25) ROADS MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN II POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 204; FIVE (5) LIGHT EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II, PAY GRADE 203, FIFTEEN (15) MEDIUM EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 204, NINE (9) MEDIUM EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 206, AND SIX (6) HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 208, TO THIRTY-FIVE (35) ROADS MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN III POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 208; FOUR (4) TRANSPORTATION SERVICE TECHNICIAN POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 207, TO FOUR (4) ROADS SERVICE TECHNICIAN POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 209; SIX (6) HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 209, SIX (6) HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR III POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 210, AND THREE (3) HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR IV POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 211, TO FIFTEEN (15) ROADS MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN IV POSITIONS, PAY GRADE 211; TEN (10) CREW SUPERVISOR POSITIONS FROM PAY GRADE 110 TO PAY GRADE 111; ONE (1) ROADS SUPERINTENDENT POSITION FROM PAY GRADE 114 TO PAY GRADE 115 WITHIN THE BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ENGINEER ROADS DIVISION BL400541, ALONG WITH THE CORRESPONDING JOB DESCRIPTION AND PAY GRADE AND INCORPORATING THE FOREGOING ACTIONS INTO THE MARION COUNTY CLASSIFICATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, it is required that all changes to the Classification and Pay Plan must be accomplished through Board approval and resolution; and

WHEREAS, the job description and pay grade for the positions identified are new job classifications within the Marion County Classification Plan; and

WHEREAS, the job description and pay grade for the positions listed is a current job classification within the Marion County Classification Plan; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, to provide for the reclassification changes to the following positions of twelve (12) Right of Way Maintenance Technician positions, pay grade 202 and thirteen (13) Light Equipment Operator I positions, pay grade 202, to twenty-five (25) Roads Maintenance Technician II positions, pay grade 204; five (5) Light Equipment Operator II positions, pay grade 203, fifteen (15) Medium Equipment Operator I positions, pay grade 204, nine (9) Medium Equipment Operator II positions, pay grade 206, six (6) Heavy Equipment Operator I positions, pay grade 208 to thirty-five (35) Roads Maintenance Technician III positions, pay grade 208; four (4) Transportation Service Technician positions, pay grade 207, to four (4) Roads Service Technician positions, pay grade 209; six (6) Heavy Equipment Operator II positions, pay grade 209, six (6) Heavy Equipment Operator III positions, pay grade 210, three (3) Heavy Equipment Operator IV positions, pay grade 211, to fifteen (15) Roads Maintenance Technician IV positions, pay grade 211; ten (10) Crew Supervisor

positions from pay grade 110 to pay grade 111; one (1) Roads Superintendent position from pay grade 114 to pay grade 115 in order to effectuate the proper and efficient administration of Marion County Human Resources as specifically provided for in this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. The reclassification changes of twelve (12) Right of Way Maintenance Technician positions, pay grade 202 and thirteen (13) Light Equipment Operator I positions, pay grade 202, to twenty-five (25) Roads Maintenance Technician II positions, pay grade 204; five (5) Light Equipment Operator II positions, pay grade 203, fifteen (15) Medium Equipment Operator I positions, pay grade 204, nine (9) Medium Equipment Operator II positions, pay grade 206, six (6) Heavy Equipment Operator I positions, pay grade 208 to thirty-five (35) Roads Maintenance Technician III positions, pay grade 208; four (4) Transportation Service Technician positions, pay grade 207, to four (4) Roads Service Technician positions, pay grade 209; six (6) Heavy Equipment Operator II positions, pay grade 209, six (6) Heavy Equipment Operator III positions, pay grade 210, three (3) Heavy Equipment Operator IV positions, pay grade 211, to fifteen (15) Roads Maintenance Technician IV positions, pay grade 211; ten (10) Crew Supervisor positions from pay grade 110 to pay grade 111; one (1) Roads Superintendent position from pay grade 114 to pay grade 115, within the Board of County Commissioners, is hereby approved.

Section 2. And incorporating the foregoing actions into the Marion County classification plan.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect on January 25, 2025.
