Description of Request

Case 260102SU is a request to allow operating a business out of a R-4 zoned property, PID 1029-005-010. There is an ongoing code case that will be heard in February. The property is located in PLAT BOOK UNR PAGE 238 - SOUTH EUREKA CAMPSITES #1. Staff has concerns about continuous legal access leading to the subject property from a County-Maintained road and maintenance responsibilities for the access easements which traverse across several properties throughout the subdivision. Staff is recommending to continue the case to the 2603 case cycle to allow the applicant time to provide documents proving legal access and work with neighbors to draft language for, or record, a maintenance agreement.
