## BOARD MEETING MINUTES THE HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY OF MARION COUNTY REGULAR MEETING OF OCTOBER 15th, 2025

- I. Call to Order of the Regular Meeting The regular meeting of the Housing Finance Authority of Marion County, Florida was called to order at 12:01 PM on October 15th, 2025, in Conference Room "A" of the McPherson Complex.

Karen Hatch made a motion to approve the 2025-2026 Revenue vs. Expense Forecast, and the motion was seconded by Jon Kurtz and passed unanimously.
