

ORDER OF MARION COUNTY CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD

On **April 09, 2025**, the Code Enforcement Board of Marion County, Florida, pursuant to Chapter 2, Article V of the Marion County Code, held a hearing on case number **949630** issued by a Marion County Code Inspector. Based upon the evidence and testimony presented, and by a motion approved by a majority of those members present and voting, the Code Enforcement Board adopted the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

The Board finds that **LUIS BETANCES** violated conditions of the Special Use Permit and Resolution No. 24-R-546, Section 2 by failing to provide the temporary restroom facilities as specified in the Special use Permit. The Board recommends that the County Commissioners at thier discretion do one of the following (1) modify the conditions of the Special Use Permit; (2) extend the time for compliance with the Special Use Permit; or (3) revoke the Special Use Permit.
