During the evening that hurricane Helene made landfall the shelter vehicle you helped us to acquire was crushed by a falling tree. Fortunately no one was injured in this incident, but it has left us with a challenge moving forward. Resolving the claim for our vehicle will be a lengthy process. The tree that collapsed was on the City of Ocala's right-of-way, and it has been contested by the property management owning the parking area for a number of years. While sorting this out will take some time, the ultimate resolution will still leave us without the funds to procure of a comparable clinic vehicle.

We are in need of a new means of transportation for the clinic, so we're reaching out to see if you can offer us a solution yet again. We are searching for a cargo van or something similar to match our increase in spay/neuter appointments, adoption services, and donation-based revenue programs. While any additional means of mobility would be a godsend, a vehicle with a greater capacity would serve us the best.
