

**CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY  
ADVANCE LIFE SUPPORT- TRANSPORT (LEVEL IV)  
ADVENTHEALTH WESLEY CHAPEL EMS  
MODIFIED OPERATIONAL RESTRICTIONS**

In accordance with the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (COPCN) Advanced Life Support - Transport (Level IV) approved on March 15, 2022, 1. AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS has indicated that it will comply with all requirements of the Florida Emergency and Non-Emergency Medical Services Act and the restrictions specified below as set for by the Marion County Board of County Commissioners.

In order to ensure that the current provider of ambulance service is not negatively impacted by approval of another advanced life support transport provider; the following restrictions are required to be placed upon the AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS Advanced Life Support - Level IV COPCN as modified during the **February 17, 2026**, Board of County Commissioners regularly scheduled meeting:

1. AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS shall be authorized to transport basic life support (BLS) level and advanced life support (ALS) level patients originating from AdventHealth hospitals, freestanding emergency departments, and AdventHealth-operated facilities within Marion County to any AdventHealth facility within Marion County.
2. AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS shall be authorized to transport BLS and ALS level patients being discharged from AdventHealth network hospitals and freestanding emergency departments within Marion County to the patient's home, skilled nursing facility, assisted living facility, etc.
3. AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS shall transport 100% of all BLS and ALS patients within the AdventHealth network originating within Marion County.
4. AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS shall not transport critical care (SCT) level patients without express consent from Marion County Fire Rescue.
5. As determined necessary and at the request of Marion County Fire Rescue (MCFR), AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS may expand its transport operations beyond interfacility transfers to include transport services for special events, skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities, 911 calls. Expansion beyond interfacility transport shall be implemented in a phased manner, subject to ongoing coordination with MCFR.
6. Marion County Fire Rescue will assist AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS with any local inter-facility transport deemed an "EMERGENCY TRANSPORT" in the event AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS ambulances are unavailable to undertake the EMS transport. AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS will follow the set established procedure to request this assistance.


7. AdventHealth Wesley Chapel EMS will make available to the county administrator or designee records for all transports upon written request.
  
8. In the event of a state of emergency declared by the county administrator, state or federal officials, these restrictions may be suspended as requested by Marion County Fire Rescue.
  
9. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Certificate, the authorized hospital-based ambulance service may provide limited, reciprocal assistance to other hospital-based ambulance services operating within Marion County for interfacility transfers and patient discharge transports, including discharges to home or post-acute care facilities, when the requesting hospital system has determined that its transport resources are temporarily unavailable and such assistance is necessary to avoid unreasonable delay in patient care or hospital throughput. All transports under this provision shall be limited to BLS and ALS levels of service, shall originate from a licensed hospital or freestanding emergency department within Marion County, and shall exclude Specialty Care Transport, critical care, neonatal, or other specialty transports unless expressly authorized by Marion County Fire Rescue. Such assistance shall be non-routine, shall not be construed as an expansion of COPCN authority or service area, and shall remain subject to monitoring, review, and restriction by Marion County Fire Rescue.
