**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A FEDERAL
HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR
ALL GRANT AGREEMENT FOR THE MULTIMODAL SAFETY AND
ACCESS MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT;
AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR AND CLERK TO EXECUTE SAME;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (Pub. L. 117-58) established the Safe Streets and Roads for All (“SS4A”) Discretionary Grant Program, administered by the United States Department of Transportation (“USDOT”) through the Federal Highway Administration (“FHWA”), to support local initiatives to prevent death and serious injury on roads and streets; and

WHEREAS, Marion County submitted an application under the Fiscal Year 2024 SS4A Discretionary Grant Program for the Multimodal Safety and Access Management Improvements project along Maricamp Road from SE 58th Avenue/State Road 35 to SE 108th Terrace; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2024, USDOT notified Marion County that it had been selected for an SS4A Grant award in the amount of \$19,020,640 toward a Total Eligible Project Cost of \$23,775,800 for the aforementioned project; and

WHEREAS, FHWA has requested Marion County execute and deliver a Grant Agreement (FHWA Award No. 693JJ32640468) for the aforementioned project; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizenry of Marion County to accept the SS4A Grant Agreement and to authorize its execution;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida:

SECTION 1. RECITALS. The above recitals are hereby incorporated herein by this reference and are deemed a material part of this resolution.

SECTION 2. AGREEMENT APPROVAL. The Board hereby approves the Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Agreement (FHWA Award No. 693JJ32640468) for the Multimodal Safety and Access Management Improvements project, and the Chair and Clerk are authorized to make, execute, and deliver said Agreement to the Federal Highway Administration.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
