My lifetime agriculture experiences and career commitment may provide a valuable perspective to include on the Marion County Planning and Zoning Commission.

I began my career, like so many others, as a child born into farming. I was raised as a horseman on a major Thoroughbred breeding farm (Claiborne Farm, Kentucky), learned the realities of blue-collar cattle and horse breeding on the family's Mt. Carmel farm, and verified myself as a hard laborer at *both* farms. Throughout university I was employed as a veterinary assistant in a mobile, large animal practice and earned my cowboychops as lead hand on the veterinary chute at the local stockyards.

Through grad-school (University of Kentucky, M.S. Agricultural Economics) my early interests turned full-time to equine. My career began at Keeneland racetrack and followed by Woodbine racetrack (Toronto, Canada) where I stepped up as the vice president of racing.

I later joined the National Thoroughbred Racing Association where we evolved horse racing's original Safety & Integrity Code of Standards that now underpins today's federal Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority standards. It was the safety/regulatory platform that pulled me back into racetrack operations in 2019 – this time as Senior Vice President – Operations for The Stronach Group, ownership of major racetracks in Florida, Maryland and California.

In 2022 I eagerly found my way to Ocala via the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' & Owners' Association (FTBOA). FTBOA and Ocala horsemen have especially benefited from my economist and analytics skills-set as we advance policies that grow Ocala's leading industry.

To date I am lifetime invested in the long-term, thoughtful management of our unique agricultural lands and the greenspace industries that drew my family to Ocala. My career experiences in a highly regulated industry and a diverse viewpoint as a well-traveled professional all sitting atop an ag-economics academic foundation suggest I have much to offer the Planning and Zoning Commission.
