Please accept this proposal for additional architectural and structural engineering services.

Architectural work:

During our initial meetings to discuss the project scope of work it was understood that we were to work with Marion County facilities for the remodeling of the former pioneer garden club and converting the facility into a health clinic for the county. The inclusion of a third-party health care provider occurred during our early construction phase, and their process, often changing requirements and time frame, created substantial additional architectural and consultant coordination work that was not anticipated.

Structural work:

When the internal demolition of the existing building was completed, it was discovered that there were numerous structural issues. Our structural engineer visited the site and provided details and instructions that addressed the following:

- Cut or damaged trusses to accommodate roof drains assembly.
- Water damaged trusses due to water intrusion (multiple locations).
- Cut/damaged wood I beam in the former kitchen area (multiple locations).
- Water damaged girder trusses due to water intrusion and repair of corroded hanger.

THIS REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES \$10,900

The previous unforeseen structural repairs that we addressed were for lobby trusses that were cut in the attic to accommodate the air conditioning systems and pre-stressed concrete slab edge issues. We suggested waiting until the completion of the demolition work to address all potential issues at one time, however it was requested that we pay immediate attention to this matter.

If this proposal is acceptable, please amend our task/purchase order so that we can include these services within our scope of work and as always if any questions arise, please do not hesitate to contact me.
