WHEREAS, the scope of right of way acquisitions and funding amounts as defined in the executed State-Funded Grant Agreement have been revised, with the revised scope and funding amounts being more fully defined in the State-Funded Grant Supplemental Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has requested Marion County to execute and deliver the executed State-Funded Grant Supplemental Agreement for the aforementioned project (Emerald Road Extension; FPN 450340-1-44-01).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Marion County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida:

SECTION 1. Agreement Approval. The Board hereby approves the State-Funded Grant Supplemental Agreement to the State-Funded Grant Agreement executed April 18, 2023, for the aforementioned project and the Chair and Clerk are authorized to make, execute, and deliver said Supplemental Agreement to the State of Florida Department of Transportation.
