DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND:

The Land Development Regulation Commission has one position with a term expiring at the end of November 2024. ~~The incumbent is eligible for reappointment and has applied.~~ **The incumbent's business and professional relations require a waiver of conflict approval to be consider for reappointment.**

Section 112.313(3) and 112.313(7), Florida Statutes, prohibits certain business relationships on the part of public officers and employees, including persons serving on advisory board. However, section 212.313(12), Florida Statutes, allows the conflict to be waived in a particular instance by the body appointing the person to an advisory board, upon full disclosure of the relationship constituting the conflict and affirmative vote in favor of waiver by a two-thirds majority. The waiver, if granted, would permit Mr. Busche to continue to serve as advisory board member of the Land Development Regulation Commission.
