





WHY A LOCAL VETERANS HALL OF FAME?

- To honor military veterans who have made significant contributions to Marion County through their service, leadership, or community involvement.
- The program recognizes not only military achievements but also civic, business, and public service contributions that benefit the county.
- The local level would create a pipeline of applicants to be submitted at the State level.



FLORIDA STATE VHOF

- **Purpose:** Honors Florida veterans who made significant civic, business, or public contributions to the state.
- Created: Established by the Florida Legislature in 2011.
- **Run by:** Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs with a dedicated advisory council.
- **Eligibility:** Honorably discharged veterans (including National Guard) with strong ties to Florida.
- **Process:** Nominations reviewed yearly; Governor & Cabinet approve inductees.
- **Recognition:** Inductees' names displayed in the Florida Capitol.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a Marion County resident for at least 3 years and currently reside in the county.
- Must meet the Florida Statute 1.01 definition of a "Veteran" with proof of service (DD-214 or NGB-22).
- Must have an honorable discharge with official documentation.
- Must demonstrate good moral character.
- Posthumous nominations accepted with verifiable service records.
- Self-nominations are ineligible.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Selection Process Summary:

- The Veteran's Services Director will form a selection committee composed of one representative from each of four local veteran 501(c)(3) organizations along with one Marion County resident who has been inducted into the State of Florida Veterans Hall of Fame.
- The committee will present its selected inductees to the Marion County Board of County Commissioners at a regular Commission meeting.
- We are proposing a maximum of 3 inductees in addition to those who have been inducted at the state level or any posthumous nominations.
- Additionally, one local business will be recognized yearly at the dinner for their contributions to the local veteran community.



CEREMONY


- To be held in March of 2026 at the SELP auditorium
