FY 23/24 – 2nd Quarter Accomplishments (Jan-March):

Public Infrastructure

1. Protect Water Resources
 - a. Agents continued to host educational programs for industry and citizens on best management practices to conserve water and protect water quality.
 - b. Agents did field visits to advise clientele of the proper selection and installation of Florida Friendly Landscapes. Florida Friendly Landscape Agent hosted the first series of the FFL program in 2024 and evaluated yards to determine the next step for residents to ensure their landscapes were done to save water usage and reduce fertilizer usage.
 - c. Water agent showcased water exhibit at Master Gardener Spring Festival, showing the community the number of gallons, a single resident utilizes in one day.

Planning and Future Growth

1. Guide Future Growth and Housing
 - a. Agent worked with Community Partners to build community capacity to assist with underserved populations' affordable housing needs. Hosted first-time homeowners and affordable multi-family housing classes for HUD.
 - b. Agent delivers one-on-one financial counseling sessions to help clients meet their financial and housing goals.
