

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO MARION COUNTY
STANDARD PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (CDBG-PS)**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO MARION COUNTY STANDARD PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT (Amendment), made and entered into by and between Marion County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter called the COUNTY) and **Marion County Sexual Assault Center, Inc.**, a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of the state of Florida, whose corporate address is 1121 SW 1st Avenue, Ocala, Florida 34471, FEIN # 93-4001138, (hereinafter called the SUBRECIPIENT).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on or about October 7, 2025, the parties entered into a MARION COUNTY STANDARD PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT (Agreement) to provide wrap around services for Marion County citizens that experienced sexual assault by providing a crisis intervention hotline along with advocates to assist in crisis intervention and sexual violence (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, SUBRECIPIENT has requested, and COUNTY has agreed to grant additional funding to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the parties seek to enter into this Amendment to reflect this new understanding for additional funding of **SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$75,950.00)**; now therefore,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration acknowledged by both Parties, the Parties hereto do covenant and agree as follows:

1. **INCORPORATION OF RECITALS.** The Parties confirm and agree that the above recitals are true and correct, and incorporate their terms and provisions herein for all purposes.
2. **INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY 2 C.F.R. § 200.332.** The Agreement is hereby amended to include the following information in accordance with 2 C.F.R. § 200.332:
 - A. The Subrecipient's name (must match the name associated with its unique entity identifier): **Marion County Sexual Assault Center, Inc.**
 - B. The Subrecipient's unique entity identifier: **ZKP1LUD68KL1.**
 - C. Federal Award Identification Number ("FAIN"): **B-25-UC-12-0019**
 - D. Federal Award Date of the award to the County: **October 1, 2025**
 - E. Subaward Period of Performance Start and End Date: The Subaward period of performance shall begin on **October 1, 2025**, and shall end on **September 30, 2026**, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.
 - F. Subaward Budget Period Start and End Date: The Subaward budget period shall begin on **October 1, 2025**, and shall end on **September 30, 2026**.






