NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, by the virtue of the authority vested in us do hereby proclaim the week of **September 17th – 23rd, 2021** be designated as

and urge all citizens to study the Constitution and reflect on the privilege of being an American with all the rights and responsibilities which that privilege involve.
