**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FLORIDA  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REQUEST FOR  
SUBORDINATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY INTERESTS.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida Department of Transportation proposes to construct or improve State Road No. 93 (I-75), Parcel No. 117.04, Section No. 36210, F.P. No. 443624-1/452074-1, in Marion County, Florida: and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary that certain easement rights now owned by Marion County be subordinate to the rights of the State of Florida Department of Transportation: and

**WHEREAS**, said subordination is in the best interest of Marion County: and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has made application to Marion County to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a subordination of Right-of-Way, utilities, and related appurtenance interest, or interests, in favor of the State of Florida, and said request having been duly considered.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, that the application of the State of Florida Department of Transportation for a subordination of Right-of-Way, utilities and related appurtenance interest, or interests, is for transportation purposes which are in the public or community interest and for public welfare; that a partial release of easement interest, or interests, in favor of the State of Florida Department of Transportation, in Marion County, should be drawn and executed by the Chairman and Clerk, on behalf of this Board of County Commissioners.
