

THIRD AMENDMENT to
MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT
FOR
EMERGENCY SHELTERS IN MARION COUNTY

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT to the MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY SHELTERS, dated July 16, 2019, as previously amended by the FIRST AMENDMENT on May 26, 2020, and as second amended by the SECOND AMENDMENT on May 3, 2022 (hereafter, the "Shelter Agreement"), is made this ___ day of June, 2025 ("effective date") by and between the Marion County Board of County Commissioners, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "County," and The School Board of Marion County, Florida, a body corporate existing under the laws of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "School Board."

WHEREAS, the parties are satisfied with the terms and past operation of the Shelter Agreement; and

WHEREAS, section 26 of the *original* Shelter Agreement (Section 23 of the Shelter Agreement as previously amended in 2022), provides for a term of three (3) years from July 16, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Shelter Agreement for an additional three years;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it mutually agreed between the School Board and the County that:

1. Section 23 of the Shelter Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows, with the amendment shown in underscore text:

The term of this Mutual Assistance Agreement shall be for a period of three (3) years from July 16, 2025. The term may be extended for an additional number of years by mutual agreement between the County and the School Board.

2. Except as specifically amended above, the Shelter Agreement shall continue in full force and effect for the remainder of its term.
