Good morning Helen,

This will further our conversation yesterday re increasing the County Administrator's (CA) monetary signing authority to \$75,000 for SHIP Rehab awards under the LHAP plan, per your LRM No. 2025-242 request.

After our call, I consulted with Mr. Minter and Dana Olesky for their thoughts re our next steps. They both agreed the request exceeds the CA's current signing authority of up to \$50,000 per Ordinance Nos. 21-10 and 24-05, Resolution #22-R-249 and Secs. 2-48 (County Administrator) and 2-239 (Procurement) of the Code of Ordinances.

As a result, we will need the BOCC's authorization to increase the CA's signing authority guidelines, by way of an amending Ordinance. Please have the CA or BOCC instruct us to prepare the requested Ordinance.
