

**AMENDMENT NO. 2
TO COOPERATIVE FUNDING AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SOUTHWEST FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT
AND
MARION COUNTY**

THIS AMENDMENT, effective February 27, 2024, by and between the Southwest Florida Water Management District (District) and the Marion County (Cooperator).

WHEREAS, the District and the Cooperator entered into an agreement for the Rainbow Springs 5th Replat Stormwater Retrofit (WR10), effective October 1, 2021, as amended December 31, 2023, (Agreement No. 22CF0003725), hereinafter referred to as the “Existing Agreement”; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Existing Agreement to decrease Project funding and modify the Project Budget, modify the Project Plan due to scope changes, and update contract language applicable to the District’s cooperatively funded projects.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Funding/Agreement Information section in the Project Agreement is hereby replaced with the following:

The Project Description section set forth in the Project Plan is hereby amended to replace the sentence “The drainage area includes approximately 58 acres of residential single-family homes.” with the following: “The drainage area includes approximately 36.6 acres of residential single-family homes.”
3. The Resource Benefit section set forth in the Project Plan is hereby replaced in its entirety with the following:

Removal of an estimated 66.8 lbs/yr Total Nitrogen (TN) flowing into Rainbow Springs.

4. The Measurable Benefit section set forth in the Project Plan is hereby replaced in its entirety with the following:

Construct BMP retrofits to improve water quality discharging into Rainbow Springs from approximately 36.6 acres of residential watershed in accordance with the permitted plans.

5. The Project Budget section set forth in the Project Plan is hereby replaced in its entirety with the following:


