Complainant and Contractor were both served via certified mail.

October 28, 2024 – Contractor Shawn Kevin Hughes officially removed himself from permit, 2023080044. Complainant was sent notification by Contractor.

Per Ryan Arbuckle there is no enforceable code by the Building Department at this time.

Permit 2023080044 expired on October 14, 2024.

There is no pool contractor listed on permit 2023080044 at this time.

Per Michael Biganzoli, Acting Building Official for Marion County, everything that was previously noted and required on the permit are at a standstill until new Pool Contractor is added to permit. There is no state statue that requires a contractor to complete the work and the Building Department cannot force the contractor to do so.

James Duryea moves that this Board find that Shawn Kevin Hughes of Trident Pool Solutions, LLC performed work in a manner that showed a lack of competency by not completing the job, not following Marion County ordinance, and by performing work in a negligent manner. Roger Sandor seconds the motion. The motion passed unanimously.







FURTHER, the Marion County License Review Board makes the RECOMMENDATION to the Florida Construction Industry Licensing Board (FCIL Board), Jacksonville, FL to impose on the State Registration the following penalty:
