Description of Request						
The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has released their FY25 Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Agreement Template. This template will be used for several upcoming agreements between Marion County and the FAA for projects at the Marion County Airport. The department is asking for the review and approval of the attached template to expedite the approval process as each individual grant is issued from the FAA. The FAA's window of time between when the individual grants are issued and the deadline to obtain BCC approval is extremely narrow. Being able to place these grant agreements on the agenda using the pre-approved template would ensure the department does not miss this approval window and would also reduce the number of additional LRMs that need to be generated each time a new grant is issued. The only items that would change from the template is the addition of the dollar amount being awarded, the name and scope of the project and the deadline for substantial completion.
