A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE RECLASSIFICATION OF ONE (1) HR RISK ADMIN SUPPORT SPECIALIST, PAY GRADE 15; TO ONE (1) ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF ASSISTANT, PAY GRADE 16, WITHIN THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT AA170513 (75%) AND THE RISK AND BENEFITS SERVICES DEPARTMENT ZK162519 (25%) BUDGETS; ALONG WITH THE CORRESPONDING JOB DESCRIPTIONS AND PAY GRADES AND INCORPORATING THE FOREGOING ACTIONS INTO THE MARION COUNTY CLASSIFICATION PLAN.
