The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to a public meeting regarding project plans on East Silver Springs Boulevard (State Road (S.R.) 40) at NE 14<sup>th</sup> Street (S.R. 492) on Tuesday, May 25, at 5:30 p.m.

The purpose of this project is to improve safety at the East Silver Springs Boulevard and NE 14<sup>th</sup> Street intersection. Proposed improvements include replacing the existing free-flow dual right turn lanes from westbound East Silver Springs Boulevard to westbound NE 14<sup>th</sup> Street with a signalized, single right turn lane for both driver and pedestrian safety. The project will also enhance safety for bicyclists by adding a 7-foot-wide, buffered bike lane beginning on East Silver Springs Boulevard and connecting to the existing bicycle lane on NE 14<sup>th</sup> Street. New pedestrian crosswalks will also be added. Other improvements include replacing and upgrading existing traffic signals, reconstructing the concrete median island next to the right turn lanes on westbound East Silver Springs Boulevard, and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits. The public meeting is being held to present information and receive community feedback.

The Department is offering multiple ways for the community to participate in the meeting. All participants, regardless of platform they choose, will receive the same information on the proposed project.
