On March 29, 2020, the United States Congress passed HR 78, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act, (CARES Act). As a Coronavirus Aid, Reiler and Economic Security Act, (CARES Ad), As a result of the CARES Act, Marion County Community Services was awarded \$2,575,970 in Coronavirus Relief Funds through Emergency Solutions Grant funds (ESG) and Community Development Block Grant funds (CDBG) for emergency assistance to individuals and families directly impacted by COVID-19.
